The conference will be at the Crowne Plaza Marlow, Fieldhouse Lane, Marlow, Buckinghamshire, SL7 1GJ.

Transport

The hotel is easily accessible from the M4, M25 & M40 motorways via the A404 and is located within half an hour drive from Oxford, Reading, Windsor, Maidenhead, High Wycombe and Henley-on-Thames.

The recommended train station is High Wycombe which has a taxi rank by the exit to the station. The local Marlow train station is small and does not have any taxis available unless you have pre-booked.

We encourage car sharing if colleagues are travelling from the same area.

Venue Facilities

The hotel has confirmed that delegates are free to use the facilities for the duration of the conference, which includes the swimming pool, indoor and outdoor spa pools, sauna and steam room, gym and Quad Beauty Treatment Rooms. For the opening times for these facilities please ask at the Hotel Reception.
